November Meeting

Hatchery

We have had a number of delays in getting the required permits. For that reason we have had to delay our Fyke netting in the Yarra River. A number of members have been angling for broodstock and we have managed to collect two viable males and a number of females. Unfortunately no success to date but we will continue our efforts for at least another month. If you would like to assist with the angling and/or hatchery work please let me know.

Albert Park Lake BBQ & Fish Tuesday 4th November

The weather is starting to warm up and that can only mean one thing, yes the Native fishing season is about to fire up! One of the first locations to do so is Albert Park Lake. The VFA have stocked the lake with Rainbow Trout and Golden Perch for a number of years now, and more recently with Estuary Perch and Silver Perch. The Golden Perch have been caught at sizes over 60cm and are getting bigger each year as most anglers practice catch and release. NFA (Vic) have again organised a BBQ at the lake on **Tuesday 5st November** for a general catch up and fish afterwards. BBQ dinner will be supplied by NFA but you will need to **RSVP by Monday 4th November**. If you decide to turn up on the day, simply BYO as we can only cater for confirmed attendees. Please find us at Cormorant picnic area at the electric BBQ. As a failsafe if this location is already occupied, we will use Grebe picnic area. We will then proceed to fish after dinner till late.
