Review of Victorian Fisheries Regulations

The Victorian fisheries regulations are due to sunset in February 2020. The VFA are currently reviewing the regulations to ensure they remain relevant and effective, with one aim to reduce regulations where practicable. NFA (Vic) has been asked to consult with our membership to identify possible changes to current regulations. Some suggestions by NFA (Vic) members to date have included:

River Blackfish south of the divide

Reduce bag/possession limit from 5 to 2 fish Increase minimum legal size from 23 cm to 30cm

Macquarie perch in the Yarra River

Reduce bag/possession limit from 2 to 0 fish

Silver perch North of the divide

Introduce a bag/possession limit of 2 fish

Flat headed galaxid & Southern pygmy perch North of the divide

Reduce bag/possession limit to 0.

Redfin declared noxious in Victoria

If you have any suggestions on changes to Fisheries regulations in Victoria, please get back to me ASAP or bring your ideas to the February meeting

Darling Fish Kill

We have watched in horror as the Darling fish kill has unfolded. We believe the termination of the Native Fish Strategy in 2013 by powerful vested interests has directly lead to the devastating fish kills unfolding in the Darling River. The apparent over allocation and theft of water as showcased in recent ABC programs, highlights the need for the Native Fish Strategy to be reinstated. In partnership with the Australian Trout Foundation, we have recently released a media release addressing some of the issues. I have attached the media release. We are currently drafting a letter to be sent to politicians and stakeholders.
